



INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

In the case of a weather delay, players are asked to remain at the course until announcements have been made. In the event that weather forces a tournament to be postponed, the SCPGA Junior Tour will first work to reschedule the event to a future date. If that is not an option, the event will be canceled and points will **NOT** be awarded no matter how many holes have been completed. In the event a tournament is canceled, players may receive a partial refund. The refund amount will be equal to the entry fee less administrative costs and, if applicable, course and lunch fees. If there is no difference between the incurred costs and the entry fee, a refund will not be available. If the SCPGA Junior Tour is able to reschedule, active players in the original tournament will automatically be transferred to the rescheduled event. If an individual wants to cancel from the rescheduled event they will have the opportunity to get a refund. The SCPGA will re-open registration to fill the field of the rescheduled event.

The SCPGA will only cancel or postpone an event due to unplayable course conditions, lightning, and any other dangerous or inclement weather. SCPGA Junior Tour events will NOT be canceled solely because of rain.
