



Scheduling Changes: The Players Tour and The Toyota Tour Cup

- The Toyota Tour Cup will now begin at El Niguel/Arroyo Trabuco June 29-30
- The Players Tour will proceed with the 2-Day Series at Redhawk on June 25th & 26th.
 - The Players Tour single day events will begin July 1st at Fullerton Golf Course.
- Since we hosted just under half of our Spring Season, we will award half of our Spring Series Points Exemptions. The top 3 boys/girls in the 15-18 divisions and the top 2 boys/girls in the 12-14 divisions will earn a full TTC exemption. We will also award the top 3 boys/girls who accumulated the most points in the Spring 2-Day Series even though we were unable to complete it. This exemption will start immediately and will conclude on May 31, 2021.
- The National Junior PGA Championship has been cancelled. Our Section will still host its Championship on July 27 & 28 at Canyon Crest Country Club. This event is only open to Toyota Tour Cup Members. Players Tour Members can try to qualify at the qualifier hosted at El Prado on July 19th.
- We will be hosting The Corey Pavin, a TTC Invitational, at Bear Creek Golf Club on July 1 & 2.
- What is left of the Summer Season will be combined with the Fall Season for the points race and the 2-Day Series race. The Toyota Tour Cup Series points exemptions will be awarded after the Fall Tournament of Champions in December.
- Age Divisions: If a player will be moving up into a new age division between now and December 31st, they will be moved up into that age division as soon as we begin operations again. For example, if Johnny Appleseed turns 15 on December 2nd, 2020, he will be moved into the Boys 15-18 division starting in June. This is being done so that the Summer and Fall series can be combined for the sake of Players Tour points and TTC exemptions. The top 8 from the 15-18 divisions and the top 5 from the 12-14 divisions will earn their exemptions. The top 5 accumulated point earners from the 2-Day Series will earn their TTC exemption at the end of the year.
- We have added another local qualifier for the Toyota Tour Cup at Arrowood (August 29-30) which will be at General Old Golf Course on August 16th.

- The Tournament of Champions at the end of each season will be revamped. Starting this year, it will be the Series Championship and entrance into the field will be based on Players Tour Points during that season, not by first place finishes. The Summer and Fall Series Championship will be combined into one event in December.
- The original Summer Tournament of Champions at Morongo Golf Club will be converted into a 2-Day Summer Series Event.
- We will begin opening tournaments 3 weeks in advance of the tournament date, this allows for a one-week registration window. This will be in effect for all events through July.
- From now on, ALL tournaments will be opening for registration at 9:00 pm.
